IN RE:ATTORNEYS - REGULATION OF APPOINTMENT OF CONFLICT ATTORNEYS IN CRIMINAL INDIGENT CASES

This action is taken by the court in order to implement the provisions of F.S. 27.40, et seq., in which the legislature has provided the procedure the courts are to use in appointing counsel for indigent defendants.

Pursuant to the provisions of F.S. 27.40(3)(b), and Rule 2.050(b)(7), the court finds that there is good cause to appoint counsel on a rotating basis within the established criminal divisions rather than from a master list because assigning counsel to each division promotes judicial economy and efficiency. Accordingly,

IT IS ADJUDGED:

- 1. The Administrative Judge of the Criminal Division shall assign conflict counsel to the various criminal division from the registry list provided by the circuit'S Article V Indigent Services Committee.
- 2. Counsel shall be appointed on a rotating basis within the assigned division.
