This order shall serve as a directive to the Clerk of the Court for purposes of dismissing cases involving the following:

- Any misdemeanor offense if the offense occurred more than seven years ago;
- Any criminal traffic offense if the offense occurred more than seven years ago;
- Any civil infraction if the offense occurred more than seven years ago;
- Any county ordinance if the offense occurred more than four years ago; and
- 5. Any municipal ordinance if the offense occurred more than four years ago.

It is Ordered,

That the Clerk of the Court is hereby directed and may, on her own initiative, dismiss any offense not previously disposed.

That any outstanding fine, cost or other court requirement relating to any previously disposed offense is hereby suspended. That any outstanding warrant, commitment order or license suspension relating to such outstanding cases is hereby recalled, cancelled and satisfied.
